





# BENEFITS OF MMC

Uncircumcised

#### NO HEALTH BENEFITS

More difficult to keep clean

The skin inside the foreskin is soft and prone to small cuts during sex that allows an entry point for HIV

Higher risk of STIs and other infectionS Higher chance to get the Human Papilloma Virus which transmitted to a partner will increases the risk of cervical cancer Circumcised



#### **FULL HEALTH BENEFITS**

Reduces the risk of HIV infection Lowers the risk of STIs and other infections

Reduces your partner's risk of cervical cancer
Improves hygiene

## WHAT HAPPENS at the Health Centre?



A full health screening for blood pressure, cholesterol, diabetes and TB

HIV counseling and testing If you test positive you will be referred for a CD4 cell count test.

STI screening

The operation will last for about 20 minutes

You will be medically circumcised by a trained professional health care worker

You will be given an injection to reduce and manage the pain during and after the operation

You will be given pain killers to manage the pain after you leave the clinic

## TAKE CARE OF YOUR WOUND

Wash the wound 2-3 times a day



Clean your wound 2-3 times a day using lukewarm water in a clean container.


Dip a face cloth into the water, wipe the area of the wound and then rinse.
Repeat until the you have cleaned the whole wound.

Wear briefs, NOT boxers



Keep your penis in an upright position for the first few days
Briefs will help to keep your penis in the correct position
Do not wear boxer shorts as your penis will hang loose and may rub against the fabric irritating the wound

Show up for follow up appointments



On the day of the circumcision you will be given an appointment for a follow-up visit. This will allow a health professional to check whether your wound is healing and to remove your bandages DO NOT attempt to remove your bandages if not advised to do so by a health professional!



#### MAXIMUM PROTECTION= KNOW YOUR STATUS + MMC + CONDOM
